DISMISSAL FOR CHILDREN'S CHURCH

OLD TESTAMENT READING

Acts 11:27-12:5

²⁷Now at this time some prophets came down from
Jerusalem to Antioch. ²⁸One of them named
Agabus stood up and began to indicate by the
Spirit that there would certainly be a great famine
all over the world and this took place in the reign of
Claudius. ²⁹And in the proportion that any of the
disciples had means, each of them determined to
send a contribution for the relief of the brethren
living in Judea. ³⁰And this they did, sending it in
charge of Barnabas and Saul to the elders.
¹Now about that time Herod the king laid hands on
some who belonged to the church in order to
mistreat them. ²And he had James the brother of
John put to death with a sword. ³When he saw that
it pleased the Jews, he proceeded to arrest Peter
also. Now it was during the days of Unleavened
Bread. ⁴When he had seized him, he put him in
prison, delivering him to four squads of soldiers to
guard him, intending after the Passover to bring
him out before the people. ⁵So Peter was kept in
the prison, but prayer for him was being made
fervently by the church to God.

EPISTLE READING

Colossians 2:6-19

⁶Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus
the Lord, so walk in Him, ⁷having been firmly
rooted and now being built up in Him and
established in your faith, just as you were
instructed, and overflowing with gratitude. ⁸See
to it that no one takes you captive through
philosophy and empty deception, according to
the tradition of men, according to the
elementary principles of the world, rather than
according to Christ. ⁹For in Him all the fullness
of Deity dwells in bodily form, ¹⁰and in Him you
have been made complete, and He is the head
over all rule and authority; ¹¹and in Him you
were also circumcised with a circumcision made
without hands, in the removal of the body of the
flesh by the circumcision of Christ; ¹²having
been buried with Him in baptism, in which you
were also raised up with Him through faith in the
working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
¹³When you were dead in your transgressions
and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made
you alive together with Him, having forgiven us
all our transgressions, ¹⁴having canceled out the
certificate of debt consisting of decrees against
us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it
out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
¹⁵When He had disarmed the rulers and
authorities, He made a public display of them,
having triumphed over them through Him.
¹⁶Therefore no one is to act as your judge in
regard to food or drink or in respect to a festival
or a new moon or a Sabbath day-- ¹⁷things
which are a mere shadow of what is to come;
but the substance belongs to Christ. ¹⁸Let no
one keep defrauding you of your prize by
delighting in self-abasement and the worship of
the angels, taking his stand on visions he has
seen, inflated without cause by his fleshly mind,
¹⁹and not holding fast to the head, from whom
the entire body, being supplied and held
together by the joints and ligaments, grows with
a growth which is from God.

GOSPEL READING

Luke 11:1-13

¹It happened that while Jesus was praying in a
certain place, after He had finished, one of His
disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray just
as John also taught his disciples." ²And He said
to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed
be Your name. Your kingdom come. ³Give us
each day our daily bread. ⁴And forgive us our
sins, For we ourselves also forgive everyone
who is indebted to us. And lead us not into
temptation.'" ⁵Then He said to them, "Suppose
one of you has a friend, and goes to him at
midnight and says to him, 'Friend, lend me three
loaves; ⁶for a friend of mine has come to me
from a journey, and I have nothing to set before
him'; ⁷and from inside he answers and says, 'Do
not bother me; the door has already been shut
and my children and I are in bed; I cannot get up
and give you anything. ⁸I tell you, even though
he will not get up and give him anything because
he is his friend, yet because of his persistence
he will get up and give him as much as he
needs. ⁹So I say to you, ask, and it will be given
to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will
be opened to you. ¹⁰For everyone who asks,
receives; and he who seeks, finds; and to him
who knocks, it will be opened. ¹¹Now suppose
one of you fathers is asked by his son for a fish;
he will not give him a snake instead of a fish, will
he? ¹²Or if he is asked for an egg, he will not
give him a scorpion, will he? ¹³If you then, being
evil, know how to give good gifts to your
children, how much more will your heavenly
Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask
Him?"
